Approximately 10 million Nasogastric tubes (NGT) are used annually across Europe

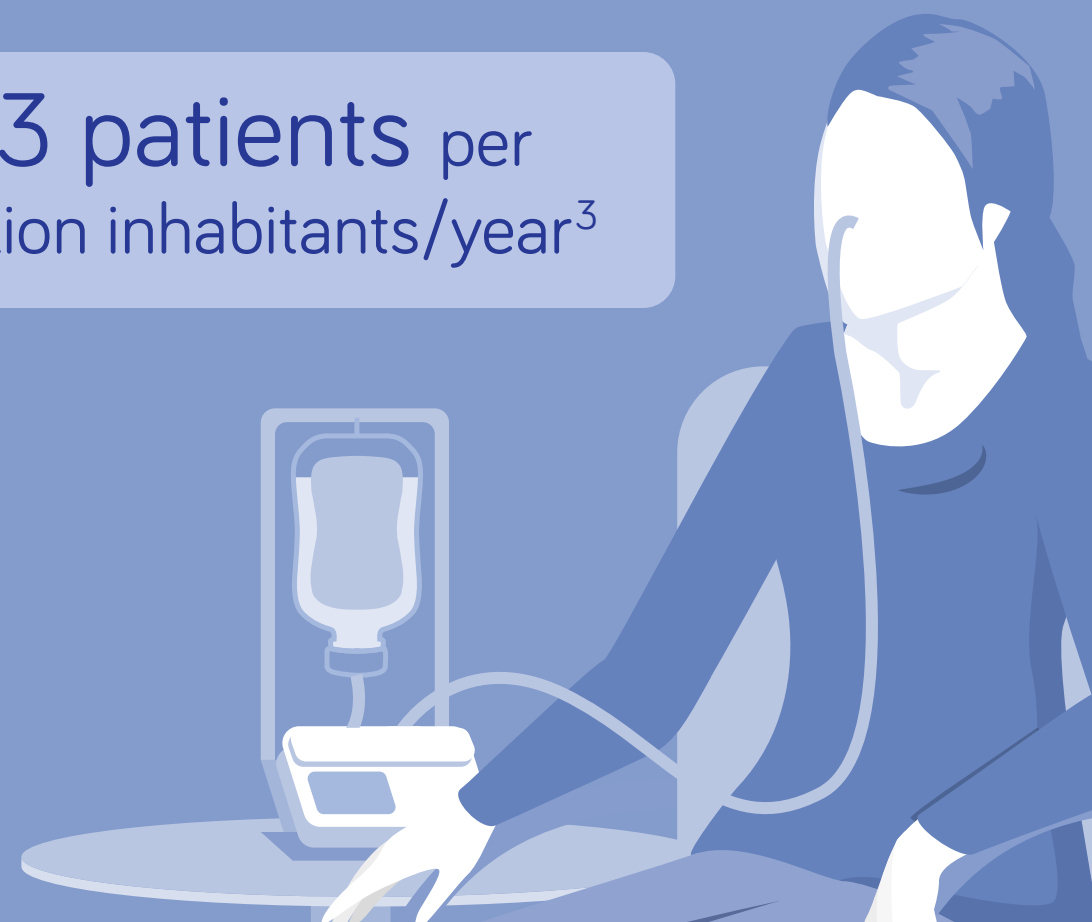
of which 1 million tubes are used in the UK alone.¹ Approximately 6.6 million patients undergo NGT insertion in China each year.²

In a European multi centre survey*, the median incidence of home enteral feeding was:

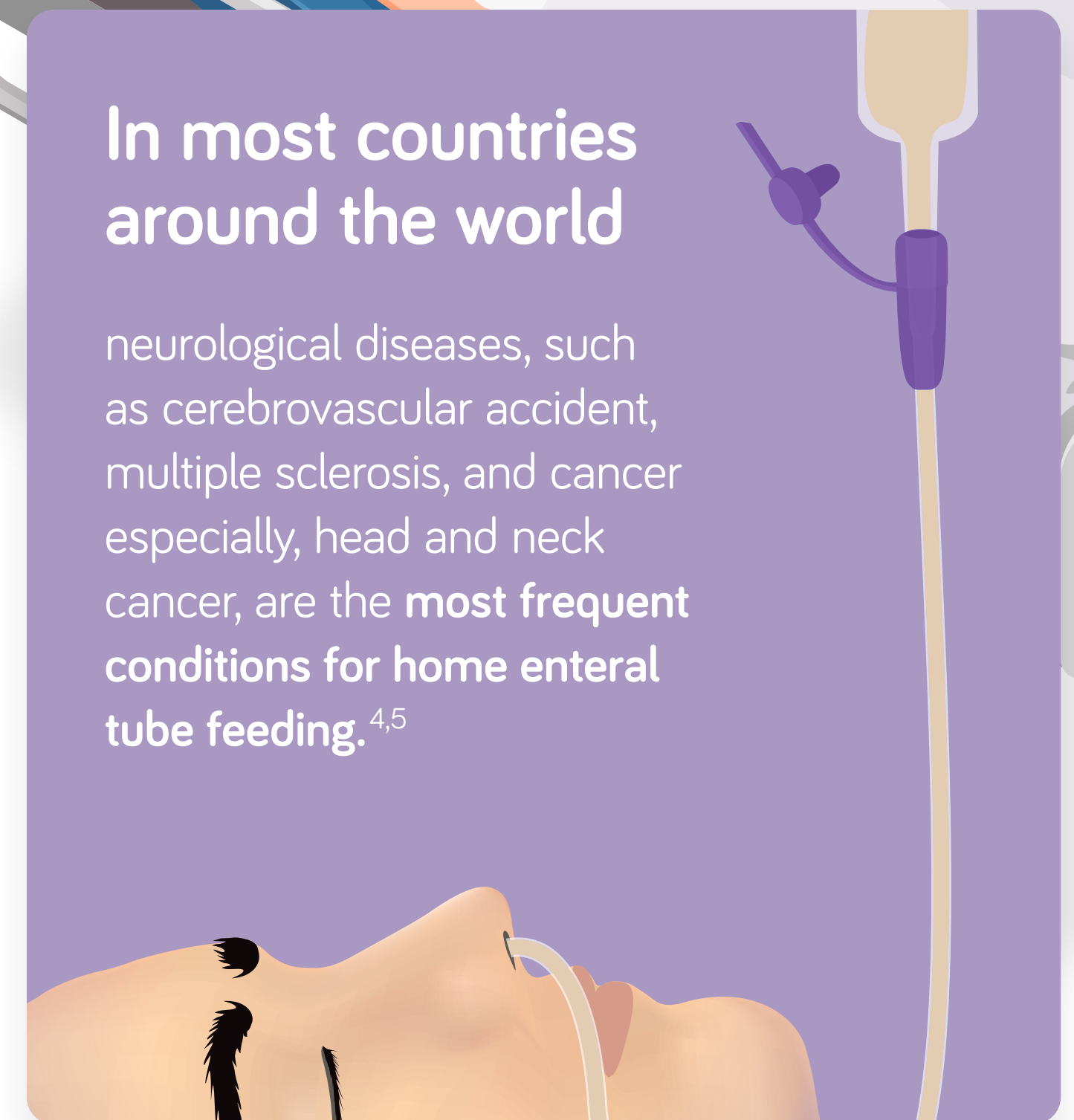
163 patients per million inhabitants/year³

In most countries around the world

neurological diseases, such as cerebrovascular accident, multiple sclerosis, and cancer especially, head and neck cancer, are the most frequent conditions for home enteral tube feeding.^{4,5}
